



Micro-shading After Care Information

For 7 days following application of semi- permanent cosmetics:

- **Do not** touch the healing pigmented area with your fingers, as they may have bacteria on them and create an infection.
- Residual pigment, blood, white blood cells, etc., can arise from the open wound. During the first 24 hours, we ask the client to "wash the skin gently" to remove/prevent build up and dust particles, you should dab this away 3-4 times in the first day.
 - You can use cool water with a damp cotton pad to prevent drying out and scabs forming. Don't panic if dry patches or scabs appear as this can be taken care of in the second 'Touch Up; appointment.
 - Apply Aquaphor over your brow area 3-4 times a day for the first few days to avoid scabbing.
 - These oils heal the brow area holistically as well as getting the best results in retaining pigment color in the skin.

No make-up, tinting of lashes or brows, sun, soap, sauna, steam, exercise, Jacuzzi, swimming in chlorine pools or in the ocean for 7-10 days (until area is completely healed) post procedure and after all touch-ups.

No hot compresses. (i.e. - hot towel)

Do not rut or traumatize the procedure area while it is healing, pigment may be removed along with crusting tissue.

Use a 'sunblock' after the procedure area has healed to prevent future fading of pigment color.

If you have any questions or concerns, please notify your brow technician immediately.

If you experience anything out of the ordinary phone your physician.

Clients need to follow ALL After-Care Instructions for good results of their procedure(s).

Remember all procedures must **HEAL, PEEL, and FADE!** This process may take up to 10 days.

Clients color will look much darker for the first 10 days as the procedure has blood and lymph in it. After the area peels, the color will be softer.

Do not use ANY products that contain AHA's, Vit A, Retinal A or similar lightening and peeling products on the procedure area. (Example Glycolic, Lactic Acids), check your product labeling. It will fade your pigment color. Read the ingredients on the back of any bottle of product that you will use.

Understand that everyone's skin is completely different. Your skin may reject the ink in certain places requiring you to get a touch up appointment after brows have fully healed. This is an additional cost of anywhere from \$100 to \$300. Additional touch ups after initial procedure may be required to fully lock in pigment to certain areas of brows.

Following all these after care instructions will yield in the best results possible and Increase the longevity of the pigment. **ENJOY YOUR NEW BROWS DOLLS!!!**
